MOTIVATION AND BENEFITS

SR 10 and ONR 192500 were developed as certifiable standards on the basis of ISO 26000 (Guidance on Social Responsibility).

ONR 192500 was created by Austrian Standards, SR 10 by IQ-NET, Switzerland.

In accordance with ISO 26000, these standards implement the anchoring of corporate social responsibility (CSR) within a company. They contain the principles of social responsibility and explain the relevant approaches, such as the involvement of stakeholders, the due diligence process, materiality analysis and the scope of the value chain.

The following seven core topics are addressed:

- Organizational governance
- Environment
- Human rights
- Labor practices
- Fair operating and business practices
- Consumer concerns
- Community involvement and development

The company must address these core issues. It can therefore be seen that SR 10 / ONR 192500 reflects the topics of the CSRD (Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive) / ESRS (European Sustainability Reporting Standards).

As they are structured according to the „High Level Structure“, they also have the advantage of being very easy to integrate into other management systems such as ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45001 or ISO 37301.

TARGET GROUP

Any type of organization, regardless of size, industry and location. In contrast to SR 10, ONR 192500 is rather positioned in German-speaking countries.

OBJECTIVES

- Basis for sustainability reporting (CSRD/ESRS)
- Basis for a supply chain audit
- Confidence-building certifications (suppliers, locations, etc.)
- Support for dialog with internal and external parties
- Promotion of risk and opportunity management
